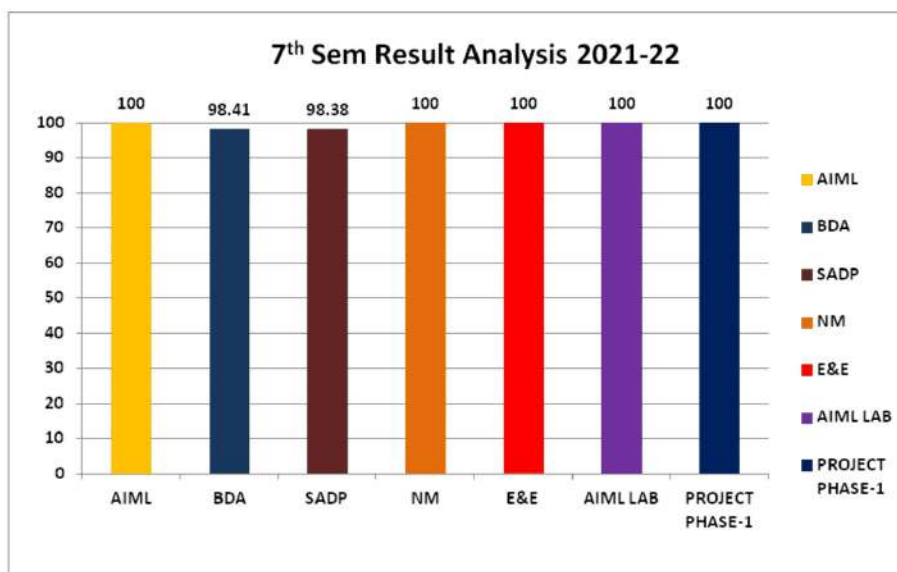
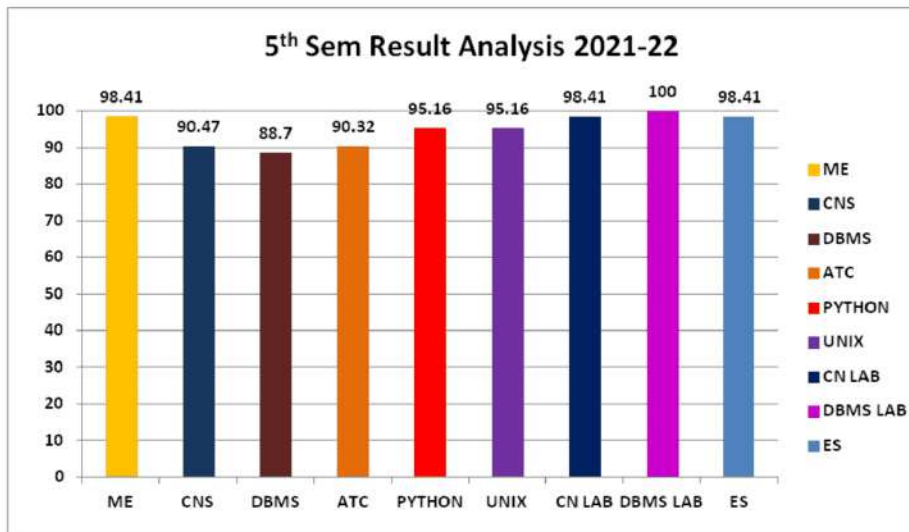
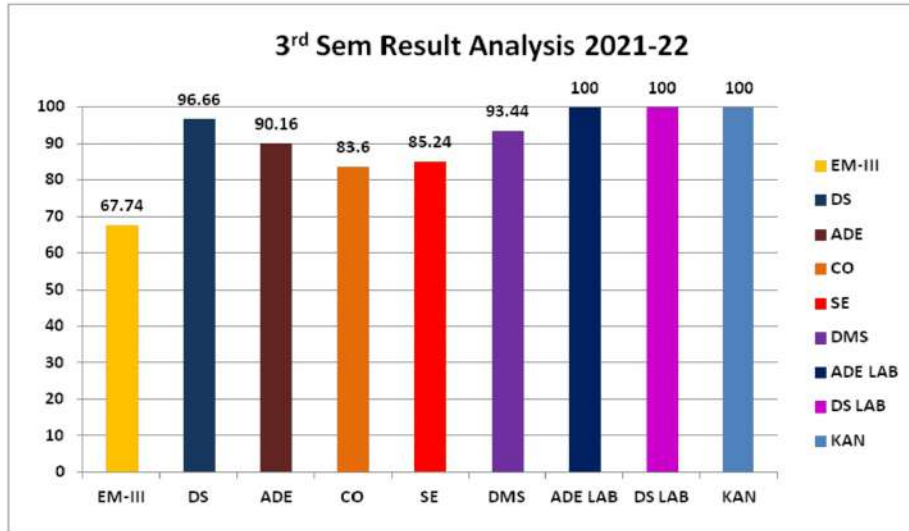
## 2. Industrial Bridge Course on “POP to OOP”

Finally the Program coordinator, Dr. Sunil Kumar B S assured conducting much more quality and useful events for the students and thanked all the parents for their support.

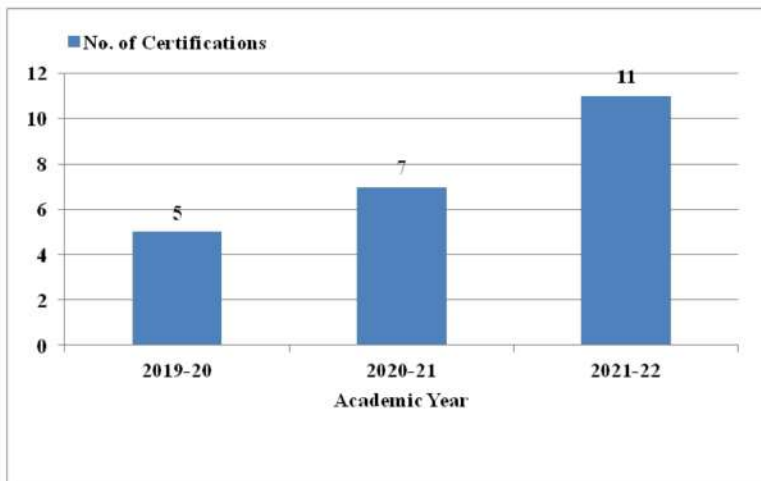

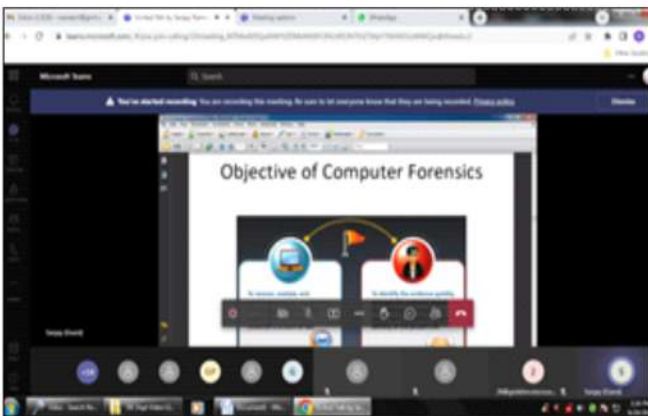
## 3. Coding competition
